Adirondack Plein Air 5-Day Workshop with Diane Leifheit & Tim Fortune

A 5-day workshop on location at the historic White Pine Camp, Adirondack vacation home of Calvin Coolidge.

A rare opportunity to work en plein air methods with pastelist Diane Leifheit and watercolor/oil painter Tim Fortune in the beautiful lake and mountain setting of historic White Pine Camp in the Adirondack Mountains of New York. Diane Leifheit and Tim Fortune will demonstrate methods

of painting, provide instruction in composition and design, preparation for painting the landscape using pastel, oil and watercolor. Workshop artists will paint the landscape and participate in day's end critiques in the tradition of the great camp artists and philosophers who ventured to the Adirondack lakes and mountains in the late 1800s and early 1900s.

The venue for the workshop, White Pine Camp, was built in 1907. The camp is unique in its "pre-modern" yet rustic architectural style, extensive landscaping, and interesting history. The buildings are an example of the Great Camp design prevalent at that time with many separate lodging cabins, a boathouse, a main lodge and even a bowling alley. The surrounding Adirondack landscape provides a unique setting for artists to combine wilderness views with the historic buildings. Other near by painting locations include the Paul Smiths Visitors Center, Black Pond, Church Pond and Sisters Farm with views of the High Peaks.

NOTE: This is an outdoor workshop, weather permitting we will be painting on location everyday. In the event of the peculiar Adirondack weather we will be painting in the boat house along the shore of Osgood Pond. A local saying about the Adirondack weather - 'If you don't like the weather, wait a minute.'

Hosted by White Pine Camp located in Paul Smiths, NY. Participants will receive a discount for reserving their lodging with White Pine Camp. Cabins will fill guickly. Reservations are recommended. Non-painting partners welcome. Kitchen space is available in all cabins. The local college has a good restaurant and cafeteria available for meals if you are not cooking.

Prerequisites

• Participants should have some painting/drawing experience. It is helpful but not required to have an understanding of soft pastel and watercolor or oil. A full materials list will be sent after receiving your deposit.

• Starting Monday, we will meet at 9:00 the boathouse in order to begin promptly at 9:30 am. Methodology

• Process — Diane and Tim will demonstrate various techniques in plein air pastel and watercolor. Diane and Tim will lead you through their processes of painting that may be implemented on location and in the studio.

• Demos — Diane will be demonstrating daily. Tim will be demonstrating three out of the five days.

• Feed back — Both Diane and Tim will provide hands-on feed back during the workshop. Working one-on-one Tim and Diane will work with individual artists offering technical advice, constructive criticism and encouragement.

• Day end reviews - Both Tim and Diane find the day end reviews can be constructive for all those who participate. The group dynamic lends itself to improving the way each artist tackles their own work and can provide the solution to a question that needed answering in the days work.
